## Placemaking in practice: the Place Guide


SFT's Place Guide is a 'how-to manual' for improved Place-making. It promotes and builds on coordination between:

- the Place Principle, Place-Based Investment Programme (PBIF) & associated frameworks developed by Scottish Government
- NPF4, Infrastructure Investment Plan, Housing Investment Strategy, HOUSING TO 2040, Local Place Plans, Land Use Strategy, Energy Strategy, National Transport Strategy etc, alongside objectives in health and wellbeing, and aspirations for a low carbon and circular economy.
- guidance used by professionals who design, build and operate *Place* schemes (e.g. HMT Green Book, RTPI on design/masterplanning, RIBA's plan of work, PRINCE2, Gateway Reviews etc).
