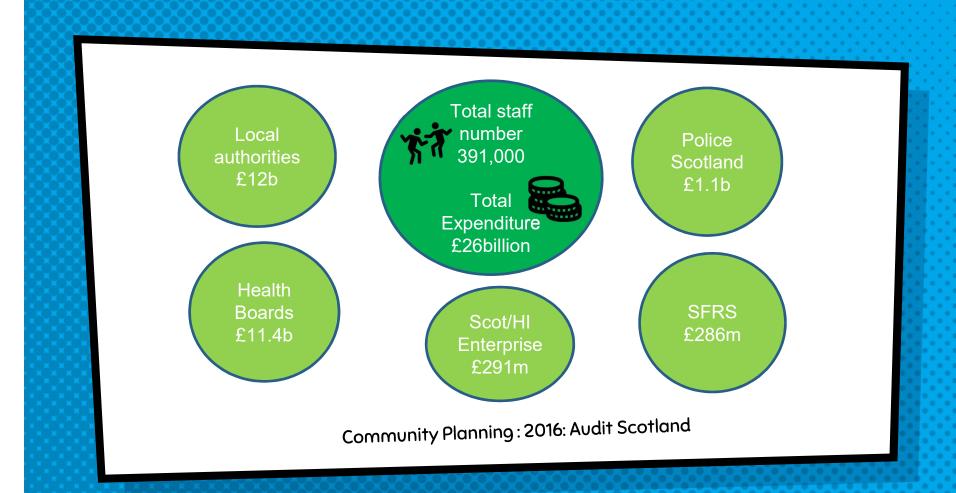


Community Planning

LOIPs - What's changed and what does it mean for Community Safety?

Stocktake of LOIPs in June 2018:

- greater use of evidence to inform priorities
- better community engagement
- focus on vulnerable people

- a sharper focus on the greatest inequalities
- more detail about prevention

Safer and Stronger Communities

Life Outcomes

People live in resilient, responsible and safe communities.

People in vulnerable circumstances are protected.

Community and public understand the role/place of public services.

People feel engaged and feel they can influence their community.

People do not feel isolated or lonely.

Measures

- 11. Rate of recorded crimes per 10,000 population
- 12. Total dwelling fires per 100,000 population

- Greater focus on 'Place'
- some are existing area plans/some new

- Community Planning Partnerships Boards and Management Groups
- Community Safety Partnerships/thematic forums
